- 12.3.** Analyze the following aspects:
- a) setting;
  - b) characters, race and gender relations;
  - c) narrator, tone;
  - d) naturalism, determinism;
  - e) symbolism.
- 12.4.** Add your personal opinions on points that you consider worth discussing in class. (Try to make specific references to the text.)
- 12.5.** This is your last written assignment. Make an assessment of the course **on a different sheet of paper**, so we can keep it when we hand the assignment back to you. (You may write your review **in English or in Spanish**, as you wish.)
