Features of typical speech and writing

<i>Typical speech</i>	<i>Typical writing</i>
1. Inexplicitness	Explicitness
2. Lack of clear sentence boundaries	Clear sentence boundaries
3. Simple structure	More complex structure
4. Repetitiveness	Non-repetitiveness
5. Normal non-fluency	Fluency
6. Monitoring features	No monitoring features
7. Interaction features	No interaction features
8. Features reflecting informality	Features reflecting formality
