- **1.3.** Look for information about the English-only movement in the United States. Which are the main arguments put forward in the controversy over bilingual education vs. English immersion?
- 1.4. Read the extract from Alastair Pennycook's English and the Discourses of Colonialism (1998).
 - a) Many writers celebrate the intrinsic superiority of English and the inevitability of its spread. Compare this discourse with historical concepts like "elect nation" or "manifest destiny," used as justification for racism and imperialism.
 - b) Are the English language and its native speakers particularly flexible and adaptable? Justify your answer.
 - c) Does English alter the worldview and identity of L2 speakers? Or do they adapt English to their own culture? Give your opinion.
